Welcome to three5, a world tapas inspired lounge bar in the heart of Chelsea. The manifesto, simply put, is to make guests feel as comfortable as possible, within a space that is as classic as it is contemporary. The lounge bar is influenced by a fusion of old English eccentricity, a chic modern day dining room and an aching hip library.

Taking its name from its street address the three5 menu boasts a unique proposition to the Chelsea neighbourhood, sharing plates but with an eccentric twist. The carefully crafted wine list and the indulgent world tapas menu serves classic yet innovative dishes, tapas style with strong global influences such as – Deep-fried calamari with aioli and mayo and Arancini with saffron sauce. In addition guests also have the option of larger tapas such as Cajun coated fresh tuna with Japanese salad and Mini fish & chips with tartare sauce. The desserts are equally as innovative offering Crème brulee cheesecake and Lemon posset, passion fruit Chantilly. Head Chef, Federico Perez Diaz says:

“Chelsea is a unique neighbourhood, with unique tastes. In three5 at myhotel Chelsea we’re aiming to satisfy all their needs in a fun and daring way. World Tapas has many forms and we’re excited to be able to share our special perspective on tapas.”

The interior features bespoke furniture from Paul Thomas design, who work with a wide choice of ethically sourced bespoke products. The rich gold colours set against the Hamptons-esque white washed wooden panels afford the space a warm and cosy feel whilst simultaneously being both light and airy. The bespoke eccentric chesterfield sofas beautifully offset the more artful repetition of the free standing artisan dining tables. An arched bookshelf, offers literature chosen by guests and suggested by the three5 team. Subjects include global food, design, music, feng shui, spirituality, fashion, well-being, pop culture and also some quirky pop-up picture books! Changing throughout the year the literature is vibrantly coloured and filed according to category – making decisions easier for the literature savvy guest.

Artwork within three5 boasts of stunning murals courtesy of Samira Harris and Justina Azrienne. Carefully positioned and based on the Chinese Magnolia the artwork is stunning and inviting adopting the essence of the eastern elements on the menu whilst adding a new dimension to the wooden linear panelling in the

space. Incorporating more oranges and yellows into the traditionally fuchsia magnolias brings individuality to the different flowers which give the paintings more depth and subtleties as the gold stems work harmoniously with the furnishings.

three5 also features an eclectic mix of furniture that can be combined for larger affairs or cosy Chesterfield sofas for the more relaxed business meeting, afternoon tea après shopping or those intimate evenings filled with great wine, fantastic food and lovely conversation. Visitors are also offered the highly sought after terrace at three5 where one can peacefully absorb the Chelsea neighbourhood – al fresco style. Plainly put, three5 is a space for guests to work, unwind or play, moulded to make you feel like you're at the most inviting address in the Chelsea neighbourhood.
